Meeting of August 12, 2014

Our president J.P reviewed some items from the events calendar of the Parkster which included the September 20th Coastal Clean-Up project, the monthly maintenance of the water conservation garden, the August 21st 10:30 clean-up (a community-driven event) and the October 4th Azalea Park garage sale.

Officer David Felkins spoke in promotion of the above-listed events. He also passed out flyers regarding the revised rules dealing with recreation vehicles being parked in our neighborhoods. These rules target those who live in the R.V.s and can result in the impounding of the vehicles.
