Meeting Minutes

From february 9, 2016

The meeting began at 6:30pm and adjourned at 6:53pm. Approximately 12 people attended.

Rudy Vargas of Councilman Marti Emerald's office distributed their latest newsletter, updated the group on recent Streamview Drive improvements; on the progress on the new skate park project at Central and Landis; and on the city's plans to turn the old YMCA on Landis into a recreation/senior services center to replace the old War Memorial building near the zoo.

Linda Pennington reported on recent steering committee meetings to adopt a Maintenance Assessment District for Azalea Park to address graffiti removal; sidewalks, alleys and canyons; the homeless; etc.; noted that Ocean Discovery Institute has begun groundbreaking for their Living Lab and placed 3 construction trailers on the private property south of the Joyner Elementary School which are open to the public to review their plans every Wednesday between 10-11am; and reminded the group of the Packer Day event on February 20.
