Meeting Minutes

From January 12, 2016

The meeting began at 6:31pm and adjourned at 7:28pm. Approximately 20 people attended.

Officer David Felkins, Community Relations Officer noted the “incredibly low” crime rate in Azalea Park and encouraged the use of the SD311 app to report graffiti.

Dawn Kamali and Claudia Ciarmoli of SAY San Diego made a presentation on the Fairmount Business Corridor's retail operating standards versus those of the State for liquor stores, noting the many repeated violations found in their 5-year project's assessment results. They encouraged citizens to report violations to the ABC or to the SDPD vice unit.

Rudy Vargas of Councilman Marti Emerald's office reminded the group about what to do before, during and after El Nino storms, noting that what to report and to whom is listed on the first page of Marti's most recent (January) newsletter.

Linda Pennington announced that Azalea Park was just granted another packer cleanup event to be held on February 20, advising that even electronics will be picked up but that they should be segregated from the common trash that needs to be set out at the curb before 8am on that date.
