Meeting of January 13, 2015

Officer David Felkins gave a brief mention of a recent "stand-down" incident near-by.

He announced the up-coming community-walk of February 21st and said that a flyer will be coming out soon regarding same. He reminded all of the February 4th community problem-solving meeting (6:00PM). Attendees had an opportunity to report their awareness of recent mail thefts in Azalea Park.

Denise Gove of the San Diego Department of Animal Control was guest speaker with regard to the issue of loose dogs in our neighborhood. Among subjects presented were general protocols and practices of her department, liability issues related to pet ownership and community education performed by the SDDAC. She provided a flyer which listed laws and regulations of pet ownership. She stressed the importance of micro-chipping dogs and cats and of leashing dogs in public areas. She pointed out that the maximum number of pets allowed varies depending on one's residence in the city and county of San Diego.

Rudy Vargas of Marti Emerald's office presented a special edition of that office's newsletter celebrating community accomplishments district-wise. He reported that a state-wide plastic bag ban is being implemented. He stated that Marti has finished chemo-therapy for her breast cancer and is now receiving radiation therapy and is attending City Council meetings.
