

Notes from the Azalea Park Neighborhood Association

Meeting of June 9, 2015

Rudy Vargas, city council representative from Marti Emerald's office, provided that office's newsletter. Among the highlights which he pointed out were: that the City of San Diego recently renamed the City Heights Mini Park to the "Virgie Hazel McCain and William Henry Carter Mini Park." He gave a brief talk citing their contributions to the community of City Heights. He also gave a mention of the recent African Culture Fest held at the Jeremy Henwood Park including that it was a resource fair.

Rudy stated that work continues to complete funding for the Azalea Park median sign. Also mentioned was that construction of the Charles Lewis Park near Euclid Street and Home Avenue is moving forward and that it will be an off-leash dog park.

Rudy states that the next community walk will be June 25th starting at 4712 El Cajon Blvd. at 6PM. Also, the Pop Street project celebration will be on June 25th at 6PM.

Additionally, the Auburn Creek Restoration Celebration will be June 13th from 11:00-12:30 at 3810 Winona Street; details are in the June Parkster.

Mark Pennington stated that, due to funding limits, the Parkster newsletter will continue as a four page publication rather than more than four pages.
