Meeting Minutes

From May 10, 2016

The meeting began at 6:34pm and adjourned at 7:26pm. President Mike Hancock presided. Over 25 people attended.

Tim O'Connor of the City Attorney's Office (criminal side) discussed the connection between his office, the SDPD and citizens stressing a determination to connect chronic quality-of-life offenders with whatever appropriate service programs are available to help them.

Rudy Vargas of Councilman Marti Emerald's office helped address concerns about the need for more police on the streets which he identified as Councilman Emerald's priority.

Carla Pisbe with ODI invited all to a construction party on Saturday, June 4 from 11am to 1pm at the field adjacent to Joyner Elementary School and requested a letter of support from APNA to hold this event at that venue. A motion to do so passed unanimously.

Robert Musial explained more about the proposed Maintenance Assessment District (MAD) for Azalea Park. He indicated that the City engineer assesses each property with specific reference to the exact services the MAD is requesting and estimates the assessment for AP's MAD to be \$20-30/month/homeowner. Thereafter a vote is held on whether or not to adopt the MAD. The MAD Committee is currently working on what services AP wants to include.

Deanneka Flores from Sen. Ben Hueso's office reported on the Senator's current developments with getting several bills he introduced through committee and distributed scholarship information.
