

Notes from the APNA meeting of November 8, 2011

A motion was voted upon/passed to amend a by-law (article 11) that allows expenditures of \$100.00 or less to be made by a vote at an APNA meeting without subsequent action.

Tom Lashbrook gave an update from the design committee on the "park project" (The APNA Neighborhood Identification Project).

The Poplar and Fairmount Streets element awaits (five years now) further action by the city. It was suggested that Vicki Leon is to assume leadership of this project (to replace Harman Nelson) with a salary to be determined at a later date. This was approved by an APNA vote. She is to present her credentials at a future meeting.

Deanneka Goodwin, of Representative Susan Davis' office, presented a newsletter and introduced a new bill in support of small businesses and another in support of homeowners hoping to avoid foreclosure.

Linda Pennington gave a report on the most recent successful Facelift activity.
