

## **Azalea Park Neighborhood Association General Meeting Minutes for October 11, 2011**

Ron Lacey, of Mayor Sanders' office, addressed the following issues:

- Lawsuits challenging the state regarding the reduction of redevelopment funds,
- Discussion at city council regarding fireworks restrictions (he will keep us posted),
- Expansion of the Convention Center---funding will be provided by nearby hotels and restaurants.
- A Chargers Stadium is under discussion.

Gabe Gutierrez, of Supervisor Ron Roberts' office, provided a fact sheet related to those facing a job loss and reported that further redistricting will probably be done by judges.

Deanneka Goodwin, of Congresswoman Susan Davis' office, passed out the Davis Dispatch newsletter. She also reported that now is the Medicare open enrollment period (October 15th through December 7th) in which to make changes. She also provided a flyer on disaster preparedness.

Bennett Peji, of the San Diego Foundation, addressed seeking input to mitigate issues regarding city growth referencing "big picture" issues and the on-line opportunity to provide feedback. A task force is in place to evaluate feedback.

Katt Eaton, Azalea Park Resident, spoke of a pending mid-November roundtable to discuss current businesses and attracting new businesses and the issue of safety issues related to El General Market. She also announced that she is removing her name as candidate for a city council seat.

Denise Moreno Ducheney, who has termed out of the state senate, has announced her candidacy for congress.

A motion was passed for an expenditure of \$100.00 to be provided to Laurie Carlock for her mural-coating activities.

A motion was made that an expenditure of \$100.00 or less can be passed at one APNA meeting without a notice in the Parkster and without a subsequent vote. This will be voted upon at the November APNA meeting.
