

Notes from the APNA meeting of September 11, 2012

Katt Eaton, as representative of the City Heights Planning Center, spoke regarding a Capital Improvement Project. The intent was getting community involvement in the budgeting process. She provided a projected list to the APNA officers to review, recommend and prioritize/rank the listed projects. A motion was made and carried for the APNA officers to prioritize the Neighborhood Identification Project to the City Heights Planning Committee.
